



Digital Languages: Exploring the Influence of Internet Language on Modern Communication

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Abstract

Digital media usage has increased substantially in recent times, which in turn has significantly changed the people from different backgrounds and with different experiences communicate online through different platforms. Use of emojis, acronyms, symbolic terms and neologisms has increased significantly in communication, moreover, it has massively influenced the emotional nuance, creativity and speed of the online communication between people. This study was aimed to explore how internet language has shaped the modern communication by focusing on increased emotional expressiveness and enhanced community identities. This research has utilized qualitative research design to explore the ways in which people communicate online. Use of internet slangs has increased substantially that enhanced the digital expression of younger people especially. Descriptive analysis has been conducted in this study to discuss the popular trends in digital communication. Similarly, this study has also highlighted different challenges, for example, decline of formal linguistic norms in everyday communication and generational divides that lead to miscommunication. Findings of this study intricate that although internet language has enriched the digital discourse by enhancing expression, but the need of media literacy and contextual awareness has become significant as well to navigate the increasingly shifting nature of communication from formal to informal. This study not only sees the internet language as linguistic innovation but also highlights the binary role of internet language in sociolinguistics. This study has few recommendations that potential linguistic divide among generations should be reduced and internet language awareness should be included in the educational curriculum to enhance its effectiveness.

Its dynamic nature reflects the human interactivity in digital spaces where different people co-create meanings and develop shared language to interact effectively. Although several changes are there yet internet language has thrived and expanded to the best of its potential. It has reflected the dynamic nature involving human interactivity and digital world where social media users co-create variety of meanings and adapt language according to their need. As Jassim (2023) reveals, internet slang may be referred not only as a linguistic short rather it has become a cultural artifact that symbolizes the humor, creativity, norms or values of online groups. This study was focused on exploring the influence of internet communication on everyday communication. Henceforth, this study has investigated the use of different linguistic techniques that are used in online communication and what implications these techniques have on formal communication in daily life. This study on the one hand, explored the role of emotional expression in online interactions while on the other hand, it highlighted the challenges of clarity and inclusivity that formal communication is facing.

Literature Review

The study that revolves around internet slang and its long-lasting effects over everyday communication has got higher attention in recent times as the research scholars are interested to investigate that how digital platforms like Facebook, twitter, WhatsApp actually do formulate linguistic norms. Internet language consists of a large number of different forms, for instance, abbreviations, numerical codes, emojis, and acronyms. All these forms come up with kind of expression which is very creative, context dependent and informal in its nature (Yang,

2024). Danel and Herring (2007) conferred that internet language or internet slang happens to bridge up the multiple cultures with communities and also enable the users to establish identities in a digital world. These results support Yang's (2024) statement that internet slang increased emotional immediacy and happened to decrease ambiguity in online interactions.

Linguistic Innovation and Efficiency

Different abbreviations such as IDK, LOL, and TBH were found to be excessively cited as a way of an efficient communication. Participant revealed that these expressions actually allowed them to communicate complex thoughts easily especially in group chats or other fast-paced environments. Abbasoy (2019) also viewed that internet language happens to promote linguistic adaptability and economy.

Community Identity and Belonging

Majority of the respondents expressed that the internet language or internet slang has become an indicator of cultural fluency among digital communities. Different terminologies are used that actually lead to have shared insights, mutual understanding and group affiliation. Farzand (2023) also endorsed this through his findings that internet slang fosters online identity and empowers social bond.

Miscommunication and Exclusion

Findings of the study showed that despite all the benefits internet slang creates certain confusion either. Participants were of the view that in certain cases slang led to create misunderstandings during online conversations, especially when they were with non-native

speakers. Zhou et al. (2021) also warned that kind of informal internet slang can cause a trouble in effective communication and may lead to misinformation especially when an appropriate context is missing.

Generational and Cultural Gaps

Younger participants were seemed to be frustrated because they had faced more difficulties in their communication with older family members who remained failed to understand and interpret the internet slang which definitely led to communication breakdowns. This generational gap was also highlighted by Zhu's (2019) that internet slang can potentially harm formal linguistic norm and consequently the gap between different age groups would increase.

Motivation for Language Learning

Findings of the study revealed that greater exposure to internet slang may motivate the individuals to get into deeper linguistic learning as one of the respondents shared that he started learning sociolinguistics to know more about the evolving journey of digital expressions. As Jassim (2023) also endorsed that internet slang may be a starting point for cultural investigation as well as extensive linguistic researches. The above discussed findings of the study patently reveal that internet language can play both ways. It can be a guide or obstacle. Although it attempts to increase and expression along with creating social bonds, it also comes up with many problems related to linguistics purity and inclusivity

Conclusion

It has completely transformed the way people communicate with each other through online platforms in order to express their feelings and develop connections with others. And it may be concluded on the basis of the findings that internet language happens to play both ways. Where it promotes mutual identity, creativity or inclusivity, it brings some serious natured drawbacks as well for instance generational gaps, improper language standards, or confusions and inability to understand the core of the message.
